8-Week Career Series Begins May 6th

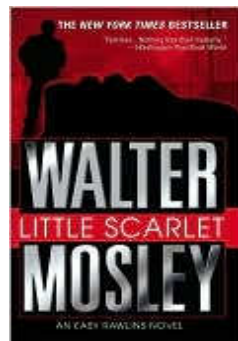

Library Launches New KidsOnline Catalog

The South Hadley Public Library has been working with our library network, C/W MARS, on our new KidsOnline library catalog. KidsOnline provides a fun and easy way to search the library's catalog because our youngest users can point and click on hundreds of images using the *Picture It!* feature. With this feature, even toddlers and early readers can search the catalog using a graphical interface to narrow down searched items. The final click will result in a list of relevant library materials.



The KidsOnline catalog also features the traditional keyword, title, author, and related searches that can be typed into a text box.

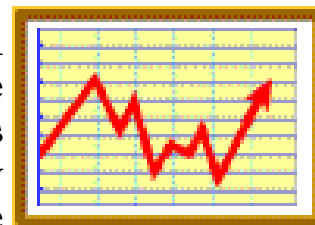


then click on Catalog and choose KidsCatalog from the options. We hope you enjoy the graphics taken from the murals that hang in the Youth Room!

Survey Says: Inter-Library Delivery Up 64%

In 2007, we counted 568 items being sent out through interlibrary loan in an average week. This past March we counted 931 items—an increase of 64%. Delivery is provided by the Western Massachusetts Regional Library System, a state supported agency. Cuts to the state budget have placed a heavy burden on WMRLS to continue this vital service. For this reason, the maximum number of “holds” (reserved items) per library card has been reduced from 20 to 10. Also, if you regularly visit other local libraries you can help us control delivery volume by returning items directly to where you borrowed them. Thanks for helping us keep pace with this important and popular service!
